PAMELA (WINDERWEEDLE) HILLMAN IS MORE THAN AN JUST AN AUTHOR AND A SPEAKER. MUCH MORE, IN FACT. SHE HAS TURNED VARIOUS TRAGEDIES IN HER LIFE INTO MINISTRIES. She is an Ordained Licensed *Life Empowerment* coach, a *Forgiving Forward* coach, a certified *Paracletos* biblical specialist, and an ordained member of the *International Fellowship of Chaplains*. Her other certifications include *Cultural Competence* and *Ethics in Prevention*, *Fundamentals of Prevention and Addiction (The History of Addiction)*, and she is a partner with the *Department of Community Supervision*, and *Healing Communities—Station of Hope*, as well as with *Transformational Leadership*. So, yes, she stays busy these days.

Pamela began a unique *one-to-one* incentive program for those who are mentoring incarcerated individuals. She provides them with workbooks and a program that can be accessed from the convenience of their homes through email and video chat.

She is also the developer of the “*I See ME Free*” *Incentive Mentorship Program* that is available in all of the women’s prisons in Georgia as well as many other states throughout the U.S. and in 40 prisons in Uganda, Kenya, the UK and (soon to be in Canada, Jamaica and the Bahamas). The workbooks will also be in the men’s prisons in 2020.

Through Holy Spirit, she brings healing of mind, body, spirit and soul to thousands through the “*I See ME Free*” mentorship program. This is a Holy Spirit-breathed program, creating a cross pollination throughout the country and the world with a “two-edged sword approach,” with both mentor and mentee receiving healing and becoming equipped for “*Kingdom living*.”

What led Pamela to have such a passion to learn and grow in her faith, and become all God had created her to be, and to have such a mandate to reach out to the lost and forgotten within the prison gates? Besides having a devout Christian and praying grandmother, Pamela has also “lived” similar stories of many of those currently living behind prison (and spiritual) wall with “*The Confrontation Within*.”

Pamela had experienced sexual and physical abuses (from age five) along with many other horrific tragedies. Because of these early experiences, she turned to drugs to numb that pain. This, in turn, led to 35 years of addiction and landed her in prison for 18 months in 2010. Pamela tried many programs prior to her incarceration, to no avail, but while in prison, the Lord spoke to her and said, “*The only thing that will change your old mindset is the Word of God; memorize a scripture a day.*”

She responded to the Voice and said, “I am on it,” and the healing process began. Her 18 months in prison was her time of solitude to come back to her spiritual roots. This was also where the Lord said to her, “*This is your college campus, your training ground of preparation for what I have for you.*”

Consequently, Pamela has been “clean and free” since then. She says, “It is not what happens to you, but what you DO with what happens to you.”

Recently, she met Mike Lindell, Founder and CEO of *My Pillow Company*, who was a 25-year drug addict, himself. He was so impressed with what Pamela was doing and the curriculum she developed, that he is now partnering with her.

Mike said, “When I first learned about Pamela Hillman’s personal
