Executive Summary

Mission

Equipping mentors to help break the cycle of addictions, reduce recidivism and help restore individuals from incarceration back into society.

Goal

To bring awareness of the problem of the high recidivism rates of those returning to prisons, to change mindsets (public and individuals impacted) of the solutions & to restore the lives of women and men ‘returning citizens’, and their families.

The Program

The “**I See ME Free**” program is a solution to the huge problem of the “Recidivism Rate”, which statistics reveal that of those incarcerated 68% return back to prison within 3 years after being released. The goal of our program is to break the cycle of addiction and reduce this rate to 20% or less. These “returning citizens” will be coming out into our communities so it’s important that we teach, train, and equip, *preparing them* to re-enter society free of those issues that may have contributed to their problem.

Investment Opportunity

LifeChangers Legacy is seeking to close out a \$1M seed capital investment for 20,000 sq ft rehabilitation building that would house 50+ women returning to society from prison.
